Nanbo Discovery Camp, our English language, residential summer camp, is located in Chikura, Chiba, two hours southeast of Tokyo. Campers are usually in grade two through middle school.

Our campers will enjoy activities that can include swimming, boogie boarding, cycling, cooperative sports games, exploration/discovery, science, arts and crafts and much more. Whether they are observing life in a tide pool, collecting shells, cycling over the next hill or riding the waves, all campers will have an active, positive, educational, fun and safe camp adventure at Nanbo.

As important, they will be building confidence and self-esteem, overcoming challenges, and working together to build relationships with other campers and our amazing counselors in a positive and supportive environment.

Journal writing and drawing are daily activities at Nanbo Discovery Camp that allow all of us time to reflect on the day through discussion, writing and sketching. Campers will bring their journals and art projects home at the end of camp.

We are up early each morning starting the day with all-camp capture the flag, fun stretching and more before breakfast. Most every afternoon will find us at one of the nearby beaches. Each day ends with activities around the campfire, in the Discovery Room or on a night hike. Campers sleep in one of four bunk rooms along with one of our counselors.

## SUMMER FUN

The Nanbo Discovery Camp senior staff consists of experienced international school educators. Upper class high school and university students make up our incredible counselor staff. Mostly bilingual, all mature, responsible and caring young adults, many have been campers at Nanbo and/or CIT's and choose to return as counselors. We have a counselor-in-training program that allows early adolescent students to develop leadership skills, gain confidence, and have fun at the same time. Our campers are usually from seven through 14 years old and are grouped together for most activities. It is important to understand that the language of our camp is English. All of our campers are able to communicate to a certain degree in English. Campers often come to camp for one or two sessions. Our camper/staff ratio is about 3:1, reflecting our strong commitment to a safe and professional camp environment.
